Rederiet Stenersen opts for Globe Wireless VSAT

Globe Wireless has agreed a deal with Rederiet Stenersen AS of Bergen, Norway to provide VSAT satellite equipment and service to its fleet of chemical/product tankers and newbuilds.

Rederiet Stenersen AS today operates a fleet of 13 chemical/product tankers ranging in size from 13-16,600 dwt. All vessels are deployed in North West European Trade.

In addition the company has ordered 4 chemical/product tankers of 16,600 dwt and 2 chem/product tankers of 19,000 dwt which are to be delivered last quarter 2009.

Installations of the Globe Wireless systems will commence in the next month and will be extended to the entire Stenersen fleet and new buildings over time.

Recently named a Distribution Partner and Virtual Network Operator (VNO) of Intelsat, Globe Wireless now offers Ku-Band and Global C-Band VSAT services to the maritime market, which will be implemented in this case.

John R. Stenersen, technical manager for Rederiet Stenersen commented, "Globe Wireless VSAT services will allow us to offer better services to our crew for browsing, e-mail, and voice calling, while at the same time improving communications between ships and our offices."
